Nakhon Phanom University Announcement Subject: No Gift Policy

Cabinet resolution on December 8, 2020 approved the national reform plan for preventing and suppressing corruption and misconduct (revised edition) by specifying important reform activities, the activity 4: Develop the Thai Bureaucracy to be transparent, no benefits, Goal 1, Section 1.1 guiding all government agencies and officials will not accept gifts and presents of any kind on behalf of their duties (No Gift Policy).

For administrators, teachers, officers and personnel of Nakhon Phanom University has reinforced the values of honesty in working with morality, ethics, and transparency, and decrease the risk of corruption. There is no conflict of interest from performing duties and "It is an organization in which all government officials do not accept gifts and presents of any kind in the performance of their duties." Nakhon Phanom University has formulated a policy of not accepting gifts and all kinds of gifts from performing duties (No Gift Policy). In order to prevent committing such corruption and misconduct of Nakhon Phanom University, one should consider as follows:

- 1. Administrators, professors, officers and personnels of Nakhon Phanom University must refrain from accepting gifts and all kinds of favors while performing your duties from outsiders who come to contact Nakhon Phanom University.
- 2. Administrators, professors, officers and personnels of Nakhon Phanom University must refrain from giving gifts and presents of any kind to outsiders who come to contact Nakhon Phanom University.
- 3. Administrators, professors, officers and personnels of Nakhon Phanom University must not seek to obtain gifts or gifts. or unlawful benefits.
- 4. Expressions of congratulations, good wishes, welcoming or condolences on various occasions as usual or as traditions, one should express by signing greeting cards, greeting books, and condolence cards or via social media channels, instead of giving things.

Therefore, this announcement has been made for strict observance.
